2026 Thematic Tracks

Proposals must align with one of the following program tracks:

1. Roofing Technology and Innovation

Emerging roofing systems, advanced membranes, digital tools, automation, inspection technologies, drone applications, and artificial intelligence in roofing systems.

2. Roof Design, Engineering and Performance

Technical roof design, structural considerations, drainage management, thermal performance, critical construction detailing, and high-performance roofing assemblies.

3. Installation, Quality Assurance and Jobsite Safety

Installation best practices, quality assurance and quality control (QA/QC), error prevention, process standardization, and safety in work at height.

4. Sustainability and Energy Efficiency

Cool roofs, circular economy principles, carbon footprint reduction, sustainable materials, and environmental regulatory compliance.

5. Market Trends and Industry Professionalization

Industry trends, business models, profitability, productivity, leadership, project management, and the evolution of the professional roofing contractor.

6. Codes, Standards and Certification

National and international codes, certifications, technical standards, and their implementation in Mexico.

7. Roofing System Resilience and Climate Adaptation

This track explores how roofing systems can be designed to withstand, adapt to, and recover from increasingly extreme and unpredictable climate conditions, including high winds, intense rainfall, extreme heat, and other climate-related risks.

Session Formats

Submissions may be proposed in the following formats:

- Keynote Presentation
- Technical Session
- Documented Case Study
- Expert Panel Discussion

Proposal Requirements

All submissions must include the following information:

1. Presentation title
2. Executive summary (150–250 words)
3. Selected thematic track
4. Proposed session format
5. Technical depth level
6. At least three (3) clear and measurable learning objectives
7. Preliminary session outline or agenda
8. Description of the unique value or contribution of the presentation
9. Explanation of its relevance to the roofing industry in Mexico
10. Speaker information: name, company, title, and short professional biography
11. Relevant experience or documented case studies (if applicable)

- What industry challenge does this session address?
- What practical knowledge or skills will attendees gain?
- What potential impact could this knowledge have on professional practice or business performance?
- What makes this presentation unique or particularly valuable?
- How applicable is the content to real-world projects?

Evaluation Criteria

All proposals will be reviewed by the Technical Committee based on the following criteria:

- Relevance of the topic
- Clarity of learning objectives
- Technical depth and value
- Practical applicability
- Level of innovation
- Speaker expertise and experience
